Steve Ediund: Steve began square dancing as a teenager with the rest of the neighborhood kids as they joined their parents at the Surrey Square Wheelers. He tried calling at a Goofers' Night, and the rest, as they say, is history. As a member of the Wesburn Wranglers he won the Senior Champion at the Pacific Northwest Teen Square Dance Festival. It is a particular pleasure to have later called for the Wesburn Wranglers for 18 years, as well as the Abbotsford Swinging Hubs, Lochdale, and Silver Saddles Square Dance Clubs. Presently Steve is still calling for the Royal Swingers (as he has for over 35 years) as well as the Surrey Square Wheelers, and the Abbotsford Swinging Hubs.

Square dancing has brought many opportunities to Steve and he has had the opportunity to travel extensively throughout North America, Sweden, and Japan. He has also called in San Jose, Costa Rica and Oslo, Norway. Currently, Steve is on the staff of Elite Records, based in Houston, Texas. Steve has been calling for over 30 years and wouldn't change a thing. Steve has worked with and mentored many new callers over the years and is proud of their successes. He has taught at a number of callers schools and leadership seminars throughout the Pacific Northwest, and enjoys sharing his knowledge and experience with others. Square dancing has been a very positive experience for Steve and he wants to share his enthusiasm for our activity with everyone.

Steve lives in Surrey, British Columbia with his wife of almost 30 years, Lynnette and their 24 year old daughter Kristen. His daughter has also been the Senior Calling Champion at the Pacific Northwest Teen Square Dance Festival—the first time two generations of one family to win this championship. He believes if you can teach your teenage daughter to call, you can teach anyone. Steve loves hockey, and has spent a number of years helping and coaching Kristen's hockey team, and appreciates the opportunity to play hockey with her during the summer and watching her coach her own teams now. Steve also enjoys golfing, bike riding and kayaking with the whole family.

Lorne Smith: Lorne has been a Square Dancer since 1967 and a Caller and Cuer since 1986. He calls from basics through to C-1 and cues Phase 2 and 3 Rounds. Lorne and wife Barb (who has been square dancing since 1977) met in 1983 at a square dance Christmas Party in Vancouver, The following year in 1984 they married and moved to Red Deer where they teamed up to cover many jobs in the activity.

They have served on several club executive positions over the early years of their dancing career. They attended and worked at many Alberta Provincial and Canadian National Conventions. Also, Lorne has called at several B.C. Festivals and U.S. Nationals. They served as the Program Chair Couple for the 2004 Canadian National Square & Round Dance Convention that was held in Calgary, Alberta. Also, they were the Program Chair Couple for the 2007 Alberta Square & Round Dance Convention held in Strathmore, Alberta and the 2012 Alberta Square & Round Dance Convention held in High River, Alberta.

Lorne is currently a member of the Calgary Callers Association, Square & Round Dance Instructor's Association of Alberta & an Accredited Callerlab member.

One of their passions is cruising and they have taken square dancers on 4 square dance group cruises and have another one planned for June 2018 to the British Isles. In 2015 Lorne had the honor of being the Mystery Caller for the Pacific Northwest Teen Square Dance Festival.

They have held offices in Alberta Federation, The Square and Round Dance Instructors' Association of Alberta (S.R.D.I.A.A.) and the Calgary Callers Association.
